Investment Policy and Strategy

- The Fund's investment policy is to invest solely in the investment units of Vanguard Small-Cap ETF (the "Master Fund") with a net exposure of no less than 80% of NAV on average in each accounting year. The Master Fund is listed on the New York Stock Exchange Arca (NYSE Arca), the United States of America, and has a policy to track the performance of the CRSP US Small Cap Index (the "Benchmark") which reflects the investment returns of small-capitalization stocks in the US.
- The management company of the Master Fund: The Vanguard Group, Inc.
- The Fund may invest in or hold foreign exchange derivatives for hedging purposes at the fund manager's discretion.
- The Thai Fund aims to track the performance of the Master Fund while the Master Fund aims to track the performance of its benchmark through a passive management approach.

Definitions

Maximum Drawdown the fund's largest percentage loss over the past 5 years (or since inception if the fund has been operating for less than 5 years) measured from peak NAV/unit to lowest NAV/unit during a decline. The Maximum Drawdown helps provide some indication of the risk of potential loss when investing in the fund.

Recovering Period the time it takes to regain losses; this data provides information about how long it took to climb back from the largest loss to a former peak.

FX Hedging the percentage of foreign investments that are hedged against foreign exchange risk.

Portfolio Turnover illustrates how active the portfolio is traded during a particular period. This is calculated by dividing the value of total purchases in 1 year or the value of total sales in 1 year, whichever is lower, by the fund's average NAV over the same period being measured. A fund with a high Portfolio Turnover ratio denotes that its portfolio managers actively trade the securities in the portfolio; this incurs considerable trading costs which should be taken into consideration in comparison with the performance of fund to ascertain whether the active trading activity is well justified.

Sharpe Ratio the ratio between excess return achieved by the fund compared to investment risks taken. It is determined from the difference between the fund's return and the Risk-Free Rate, compared to the fund's volatility (Standard Deviation). The Sharpe Ratio reflects the excess return the fund generates given its risk exposure. A fund with a higher Sharpe Ratio denotes a better-managed fund since it is able to generate a higher return over a similar risk exposure.

Alpha excess return generated by the fund when compared to its benchmark index. A high Alpha figure illustrates that the fund is able to achieve a higher return than the benchmark due to the fund managers' ability to select good investments and appropriate timing.

Beta magnitude and direction of the performance of securities in the portfolio relative to the market's return. A Beta lower than 1 denotes that the return of the securities in the portfolio is less sensitive to changes in the market's return. A Beta higher than 1 indicates that the return of the securities in the portfolio deviates by a larger magnitude in comparison to changes in the market's return.

Tracking Error the fund's ability to replicate the performance of its benchmark index is measured as Tracking Error. A low figure shows that the fund can efficiently match the benchmark's movement and generate similar performance. A fund with a high tracking error will generally have average returns that deviate from the benchmark index.

Yield to Maturity the return from investment in a fixed income instrument that is held until maturity. It is calculated from the stream of coupon payments to receive in the future plus the principal to be paid back, adjusted into present value terms. It indicates the overall return of a fixed income fund by summing the weighted average Yield to Maturity of each fixed income instrument in the portfolio. Since Yield to Maturity is expressed as a percentage per annum, it can be conveniently used to compare fixed income funds which will hold their debt securities until maturity and have similar investment policies.
